Government Leaders and Elections

As we see in the first Prayer Focus Scripture below we are actually called to pray for all of those in authority over us at all times. Interestingly this verse actually commands us to lift up four different kinds of prayers. (We will take a deeper look into this passage for some deeper study at a later time.)

In addition, as I, and many others have said regarding the upcoming election, we are at a pivotal point in time for our country and ultimately the whole world. We must pray specifically for The Lord's will to be done in these and God fearing leaders be elected at all levels of leadership. We MUST pray them into the positions for which GOD has already appointed and anointed them.

I encourage you to read, meditate on and pray these passages as we prepare for next week's meeting where we will focus our prayers on our leaders and the elections.

1 Timothy 2:1-5

[1] I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people— [2] for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. [3] This is good, and pleases God our Savior, [4] who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. [5] For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus,
